

Follow-up on Employee Parking registration

From May 14 – 29, UNC Health Care's Parking and Transportation office hosted parking registration for the 2012-2013 parking year that begins Aug. 15. This year 4,875 employees registered for on campus parking, an increase of more than 300 people from last year. This increase in registration, in combination with the loss of permits in Craige Deck due to construction, led to there being 697 Hospital employees who were unable to receive an on-campus permit. Last year at this same time 459 employees were unable to receive an on-campus permit.

As in previous years, parking was allocated based on years of service and then the first and second choices of each applicant. Those who did not receive on-campus parking are automatically placed on the waitlist for the first choice they picked during the registration period. If you want to change your waitlist choice, please work with your parking coordinator, who can share your new waitlist choice with the Parking and Transportation Office. Beginning Aug. 31, you can go on the [Parking & Transportation website](#) and update your waitlist selection online.

Permits for the new parking year go into effect Aug. 15. Each September, the University conducts audits of lots/decks across campus to determine if any new permits can be allocated. These additional permits may be limited this year due to Craige Deck construction and increased demand for permits across the University. Craige Deck construction is scheduled to begin in September 2012 and be completed by January 2014. When Craige Deck construction is complete, UNC Hospitals' permit allocation will increase by 430 permits, not including the 396 permits lost due to construction.
