



FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The UNC Health Financial Assistance Program helps relieve the financial burden of medically necessary health care services at participating UNC Health entities. The program is available to North Carolina residents with a household income at or below 250% of the Federal Poverty Guideline for your family size.

AM I ELIGIBLE FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE?

If you answer 'Yes' to the following questions you may be eligible for the UNC Health Financial Assistance program.

1. Are you a North Carolina resident?
2. For your family size, does your income fall at or below the amount listed below?

| Family Size | Household Income Limit |
|-------------|------------------------|
| 1 | \$32,200 |
| 2 | \$43,550 |
| 3 | \$54,900 |
| 4 | \$66,250 |
| 5 | \$77,600 |
| 6 | \$88,950 |

To determine eligibility for financial assistance, you must complete the financial assistance application and provide the required supporting documents.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE GUIDELINES

Financial Assistance is available for health care services and procedures that meet medical necessity criteria. Coverage exclusions include, but are not limited to, cosmetic and elective procedures.

If you qualify for financial assistance, you will see adjustments applied after insurance, federal or state assistance, or other third-party coverage.

Screening for Medicaid, or other coverage programs, is required. Contact your local county department of social services to complete the Medicaid application or complete the eligibility screening by calling 866-704-5286.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE COPAYMENTS

All patients approved for Financial Assistance are asked to pay copayments. If you have insurance in addition to Financial Assistance, the copayment applied by your insurance company will be expected instead of the Financial Assistance copayment.

| Copayment | Service |
|-----------|--|
| \$10 | Primary care or specialty visit |
| \$10 | Imaging or Lab |
| \$20 | Recurring therapy services |
| \$35 | Urgent Care Visits (excludes Pardee) |
| \$50 | Emergency Room |
| \$75 | Outpatient Surgery/Recurring Radiation |
| \$100 | Inpatient Admission |

NEED HELP WITH HEALTHCARE EXPENSES?

We ask each patient to actively participate with all financial assistance efforts by:

- Discussing your financial status with a financial navigator
- Setting up and maintaining a payment plan that fits your needs
- Seeking all methods of coverage, such as plans available through the Healthcare Insurance Marketplace, Medicaid or disability benefits if eligible.

UNINSURED DISCOUNT

If you are uninsured or do not have access to U.S. medical insurance, you will receive a 40% discount to your bill. You are not required to complete a Financial Assistance application to receive the uninsured discount.
