

## Accelerated Training Options for Surgeons or Proceduralists

This Tip Sheet covers the Surgeon or Proceduralist Accelerated Training Options (ATO) process through LMS and the Playground environment.

The following Surgeon or Proceduralist curricula in LMS offer ATOs for users with *prior* Epic experience. The process to opt-out includes the following steps, which are detailed on the previous Epic@UNC Training page:

- Login to MyApps; <https://myapps.unchealth.unc.edu> with your User ID and Password to access LMS and the Playground environment to complete the assessment.
- Register for the Accelerated Surgeon or Proceduralist Assessment in LMS.
- After registering, LMS will automatically launch the Accelerated Questionnaire.
- After completing the Accelerated Questionnaire, the assessment instructions and assessment questions will appear.
- Upon completing the assessment (pass/fail), a screen appears for the end user to register for either the appropriate ATO(s) that corresponds with the Instructor-led course(s) or the appropriate instructor-led curricula training. See shaded table below.
- Log into the **Epic@UNC Playground** with the username and password provided on the Start Screen of the Accelerated Assessment (Playground logins and patient scenarios are also listed on the last page of this document).

**NOTE:** This is **NOT** an all-inclusive list of the required courses in each curricula, *only* those with available ATOs. Please see LMS for the full listing of required courses for each role.

## Find and Register for the Accelerated Training Option Assessments

Refer to the table above to locate the appropriate ATO course code listed to register for the appropriate assessment. Follow the instructions below to locate the Accelerated Surgeon or Proceduralist Assessment.


**\*\*\* NOTE: ATO assessments launch once LMS has confirmed eligibility after a user's passing score on the required Accelerated Training Options Eligibility Questionnaire**

### Rules:

- **Read ALL instructions carefully as no retakes are permitted under any circumstance for an ATO.**
- ATOs require a **minimum** of an 85% passing score.
- The Epic@UNC Playground Environment **must be used** while completing an ATO. Make sure the computer used to complete an ATO can run both Playground and LMS simultaneously.
- Once you pass, you are eligible to register for the **Accelerated Surgeon or Proceduralist -Inpatient Only Online Training Curriculum**, which includes an **Accelerated Inpatient Provider 100 Online Training Class**.


**Failure** to pass the ATO **requires** users to register for and complete the corresponding Instructor-Led courses listed in your NEO curriculum (page one table).

1. In the **Search field** of LMS, enter the appropriate ATO course code **listed in the table above** for the ATO Assessment to be completed. **Example:** Accelerated Surgeon or Proceduralist Assessment-EPIC\_ATO\_OPTSUR\_TST.
2. Once the assessment is located, register for the activity.

If you do pass this accelerated assessment with an 85% or greater, you will NOT need to register for the Surgeon or Proceduralist class." There is a "SELECT" button on the right side of the card.

3. The description and start screen of the assessment provide the username, password, department, and patients (if applicable) that must be used in the Playground environment in order to complete the assessment. It is a good idea to write down this information in the event that the Playground environment must be relaunched after starting the assessment.
