

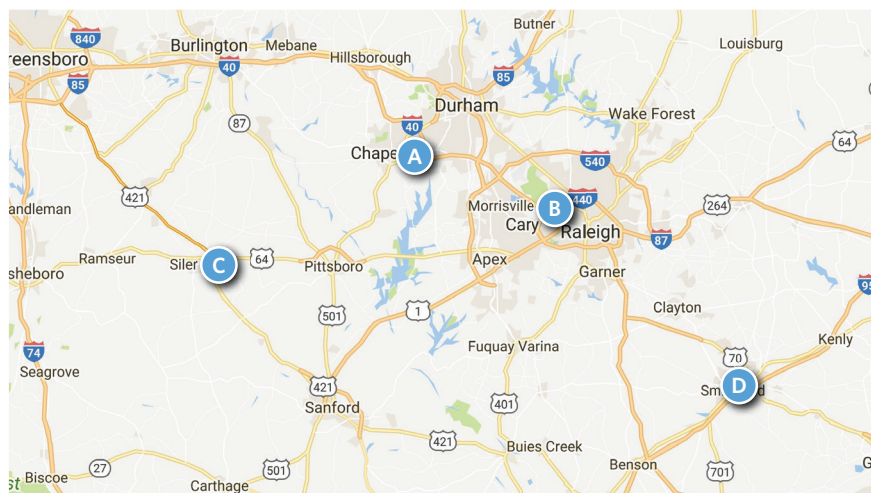
AFib Transitions of Care provides easy access to specialty care for your AFib patients within 72 hours of being evaluated by a provider. The AFib Transitions of Care aims to prevent hospitalizations, initiate high quality comprehensive care, and help patients build the self-management skills they need to transition back to their primary care team.

GOALS

- Provide a new pathway for management of patients with atrial fibrillation
- Prevent unnecessary hospitalizations and Emergency Department visits
- Improve quality of AFib care
- Increase patient engagement through education and individualized treatment plans

APPROACH TO CARE

- Provide short-term transitional care with option for ongoing specialty care if needed
- Improved access to specialty care for underserved populations
- Development of a comprehensive management plan in partnership with the patient’s primary care team
- Guaranteed appointments within 72 hours of initial evaluation with appointment scheduling available 24/7
